In the year 2004 I went to Pamozi Clinic for Voluntary Counselling and Testing (VCT) for the first time and I was found positive of HIV/AIDS.

I again had another test in 2009 and proved positive. Unfortunately, I was pregnant and was very worried about my health and of the child to be born. I decided not to be on ARV treatment.

There was a moment brother Joe Mubambe of the Revival Fellowship of Ndola branch preached to me about the basic salvation message. Thereafter I was invited to attend their Sunday communion service although I was not involved in all they did. I was prayed for by Pastor Whiteson during prayer line.

Secondly, I attended a house meeting on one of the Wednesdays. I was again prayed for by Sister Agatha, Pastor Whiteson's wife. Later on I was baptised and received the power of the Holy Ghost with an evidence of speaking in other tongues.

I went for the third test in January 2010. Amazingly, the results were negative. Doctors could not believe it.

Now I have a 3 month old healthy baby boy. I am now able to breastfeed him.
