A little over 6 years ago my wife Leonie and I started to go over to Kangaroo

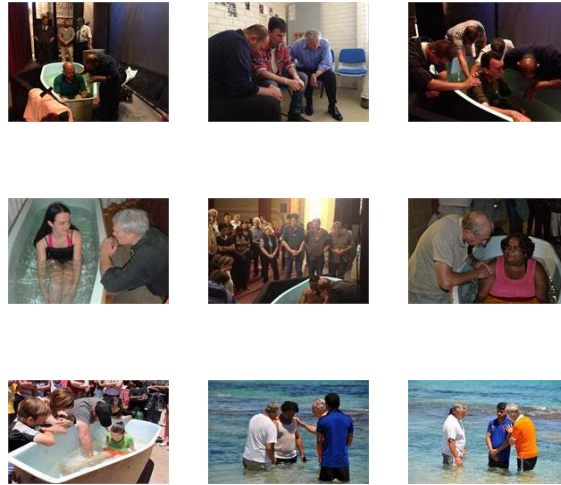

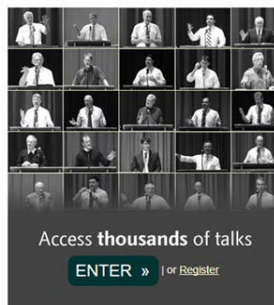
